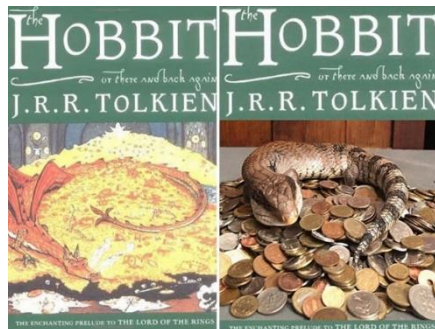

Create a bookmark with a design of your favourite book. Colour it in and when we return to school, bring it in and we will laminate it for you to keep forever!

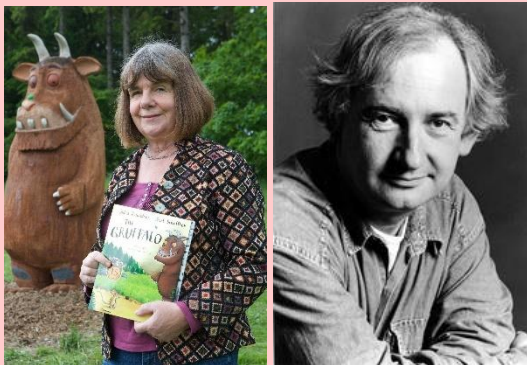
